She arrived at the lake early and none of the lake was in the shadows.

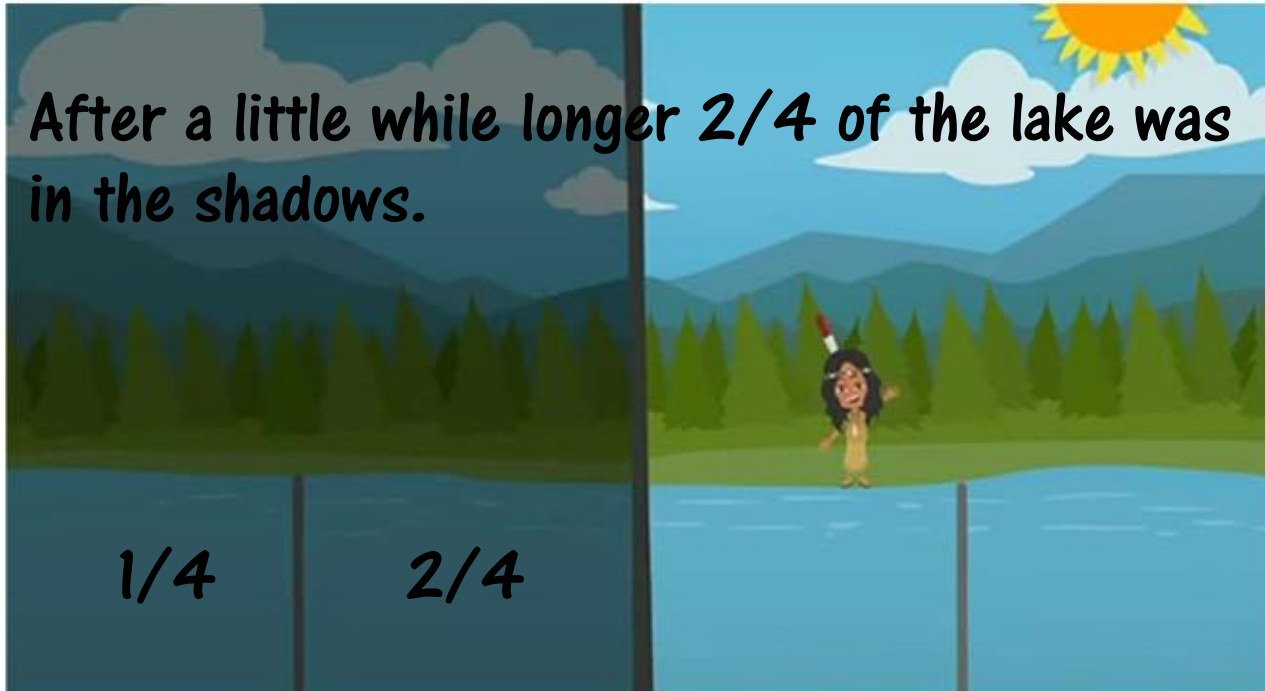
- The lake can be broken into 4 parts.

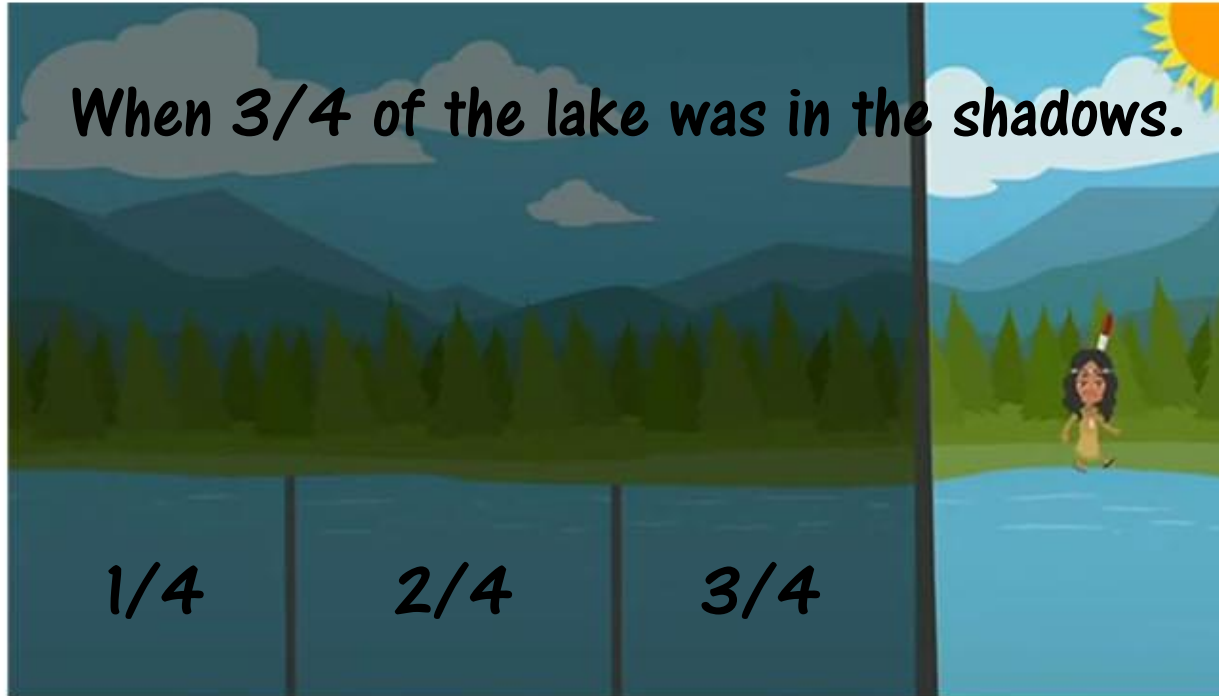


When $\frac{3}{4}$ of the lake was in the shadows.

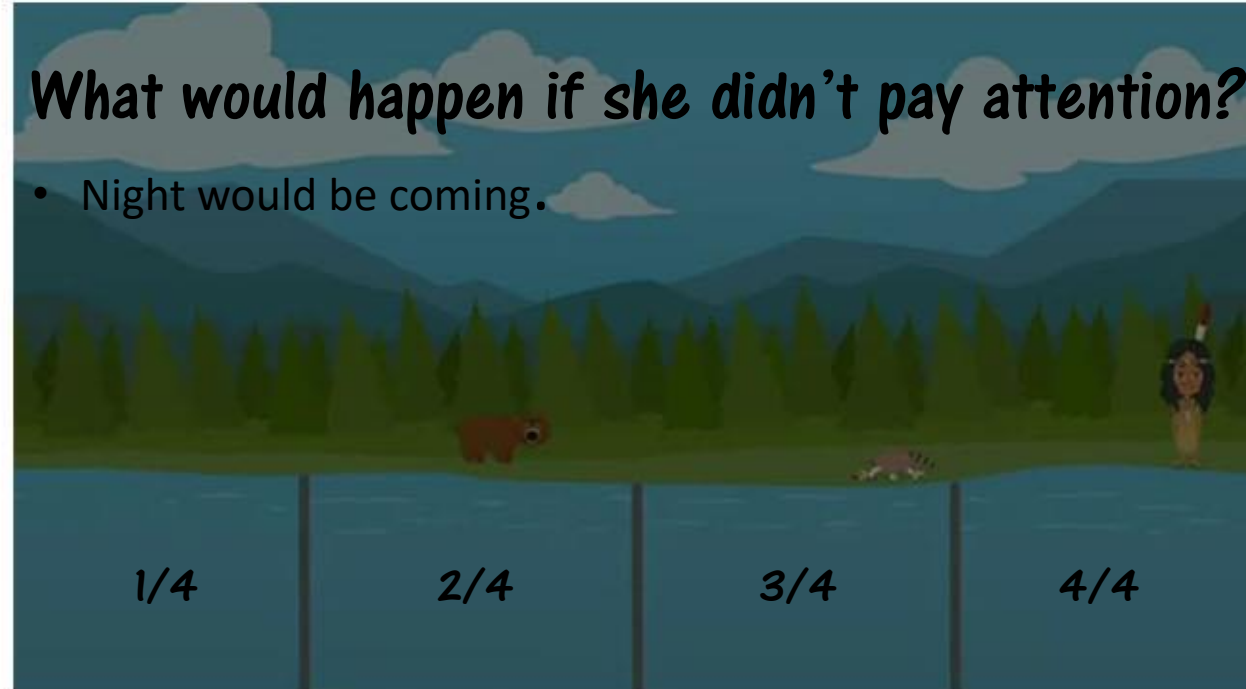


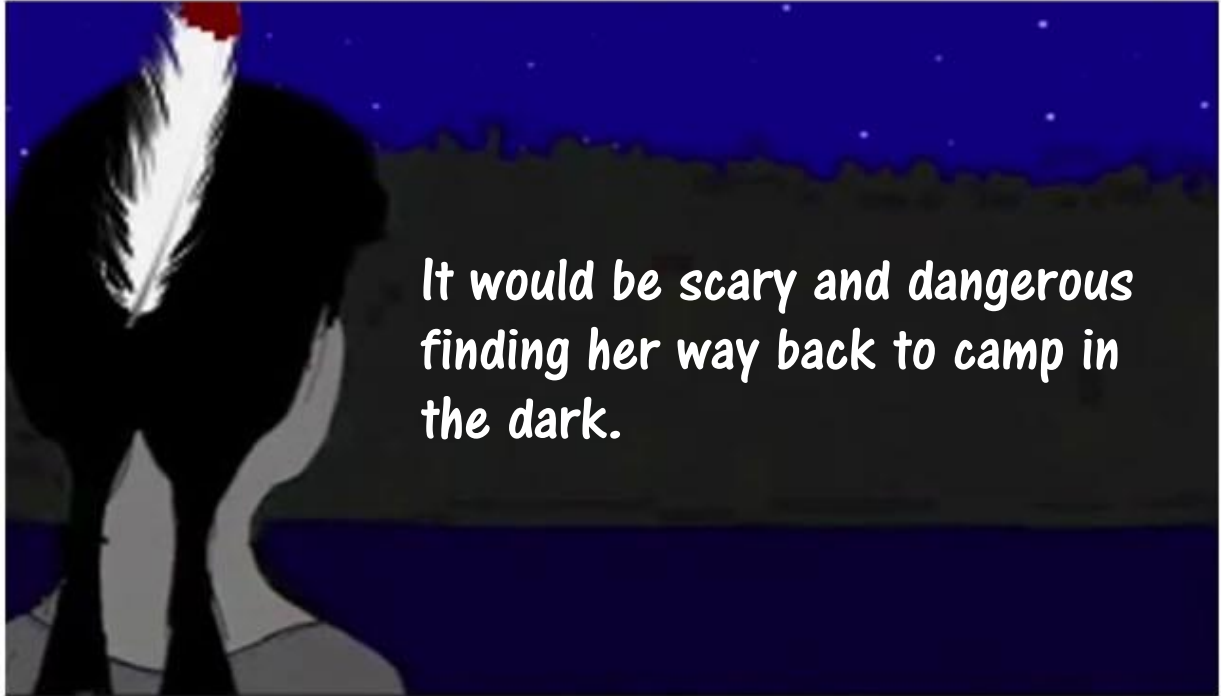
It was time to get up and go home.
